



How to Whitelist Our Emails Instructions for Yahoo! Mail

To keep our emails from landing in your spam folder on Yahoo! Mail, and make sure that you receive all of the important stuff that we send you, carefully follow these instructions:

First, report our emails as "Not Spam":

1. Check your Yahoo! Bulk folder.
2. Highlight the emails from DougHoltOnline, and click "Not Spam".

Unfortunately, this does not guarantee that your email will be delivered properly in the future, but it does help.

To be extra-sure that you'll get our messages, you should...

Second, create a Filter:

1. Click on "Options" in the top-right navigation bar, and select "Mail Options" from the drop-down list.
2. Click on "Filters" (on the left-side of the page).
3. Click the "Add" button on the Filters page.
4. Choose the "From" field to match in incoming messages.
5. Choose "contains" as the criterion by which you want a match to be made.
6. Enter "*@dougholtonline.com" as the text string to compare.
7. Choose "Inbox" as the destination folder to which you want the message delivered.
